At our Spring Awards Assembly, a student from each homeroom is chosen for best representing the criteria in the following categories:

Most Helpful

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify encouragement and support of others.

Most Conscientious

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify kindness, courtesy, and respect towards others.

Most Congenial

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify amiable character.

Most Cooperative

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify collaboration with others.

Most Improved

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify significant advancement in academic standing through improved attitude, organizational skills, and desire to succeed.

Musicianship

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify a high level of achievement in performance and dedication to the music program at school.

Sportsmanship

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify a high level of skill, sportsmanship, and school spirit as a member of a school team and/or as a student in the regular physical education program.

Citizenship

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify a spirit of citizenship that has benefited other students, staff, and the school community at large.

- Awarded to the student with the highest academic achievement, coupled with excellent work habits.

- Awarded to the student who best demonstrates the personal qualities and behaviors that exemplify punctuality and perfect attendance.
